PRIVACY STATEMENT FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS

This PRIVACY STATEMENT FOR CALIFORNIA RESIDENTS ("California Privacy Statement") supplements the information contained in the Privacy Policy of Prime Acceptance Corp. DBA PAC Auto Finance and its subsidiaries (collectively, "PAC," "we," "us," or "our"). This California Privacy Statement applies solely to visitors, users, and others who reside in the State of California ("consumers" or "you"). We adopt this California Privacy Statement to comply with the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 ("CCPA") and other California privacy laws. Any terms defined in the CCPA have the same meaning when used in this California Privacy Statement.

Please note that the practices described below only cover information subject to the CCPA. Not all information we collect from you is subject to the CCPA. PAC applies privacy and security protections to your personal information as required by United States federal law. As such, most of the personal information about you that we may collect and use is exempt from the CCPA, with only a relatively small dataset of personal information being subject to the CCPA.

If you are a current or former customer, the data collected relating to your account is covered by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act ("GLBA"), and you may review our GLBA privacy notice <u>here</u> to learn what we do with that information and to learn more about opting out of that type of information sharing.

Information We Collect

This Privacy Statement explains what information we collect and how we use that information on PAC websites and, where we specifically note, offline. We may collect information that identifies, relates to, describes, references, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household ("Personal Information"). Personal information does not include:

- Publicly available information from government records.
- Deidentified or aggregated consumer information.
- Information excluded from the CCPA's scope, like personal information covered by certain sector-specific privacy laws, including the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA) or California Financial Information Privacy Act (FIPA), and the Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994.

Here are your rights under the CCPA:

Request to Know

You may request no more than twice in any 12-month period and, subject to verification of your identity and certain exemptions, we will provide:

- The categories of Personal Information we collected about you.
- The categories of sources from which the Personal Information is collected.
- The categories of Personal Information sold or shared for purposes of cross-contextual advertising to a third party, as well as the categories of third parties to whom such personal

- information was disclosed, by category of categories of personal information for each category of third party.
- The categories of Personal Information that the business disclosed about the consumer for a business purpose and the categories of persons to whom it was disclosed for a business purpose.
- Our business or commercial purpose for collecting, selling, or sharing for purposes of crosscontextual advertising your Personal Information.
- The specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about you.

• Request to Delete

You may request that we delete Personal Information we have collected from you, subject to verification of your identity and the exceptions provided by law.

• Request to Correct

You may request that we correct inaccurate Personal Information we have collected from you, subject to verification of your identity and exceptions provided by law.

Request Not to Sell or Share Personal Information

You have the right to opt-out from having your Personal Information and Sensitive Personal Information sold to third parties. You also have the right to opt-out from having your Personal Information and Sensitive Personal Information shared with third parties for purposes of cross-contextual advertising. We do not sell your Personal Information or Sensitive Personal Information, and we do not share such information with third parties for purposes of cross-contextual advertising. We have no actual knowledge of any sales or sharing of Personal Information or Sensitive Personal Information of minors under 16 years of age.

• Request to Limit Use and Disclosure

You may request that we limit the use and disclosure of your Sensitive Personal Information.

These rights are subject to various exclusions and exceptions under applicable laws and are also subject to our being able to reasonably verify your identity and authority to make a request. To facilitate this verification, you must provide us with your full legal name and mailing address, and we may need to request further information.

Any requests should contain, at a minimum, first name, last name, address, email address, phone number, details of your request.

Only you or a person registered with the California Secretary of State that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable consumer request related to your personal information.

We cannot respond to your request or provide you with personal information if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm the personal information relates to you. Making a verifiable consumer request does not require you to create an account with us. We will only use personal information provided in a verifiable consumer request to verify the requestor's identity or authority to make the request.

Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your CCPA rights. Unless permitted by the CCPA, we will not:

- Deny you goods or services.
- Charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties.
- Provide you a different level or quality of goods or services.
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.

Other California Privacy Rights.

California's "Shine the Light" law (Civil Code Section § 1798.83) permits users of our websites that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of personal information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes.
